We have an excellent week planned for you in June at California State University-Monterey Bay. The faculty and University staff are busily preparing for this exciting experience.

The enclosed [campus map](#) should assist in your journey to CSUMB. Dorm check-in will be on Monday, June 26th, 3:30-6:30 p.m. and Institute check-in Tuesday, June 27th from 6:30-8:00 a.m. (for details see enclosed campus map). A binder, tote bag, name tag, and parking permit, if needed, will be issued at check-in.

The welcoming event and orientation will begin at 8:00 a.m. in the University Center Ballroom on Tuesday, June 27th. Participants will receive an overview of campus life, areas of interest, and the week in review.
